OPERATING POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

Welcome to Gloria Dei Preschool and Kindergarten. Please read through this information carefully and keep it for future reference. This booklet has been designed to help you understand our program and policies.

PURPOSE STATEMENT

We are happy to be part of your family's life. Our purpose is to extend the ministry of Gloria Dei Lutheran Church by providing a quality preschool and kindergarten program with a nurturing, God-centered environment.

GOALS AND OBJECTIVES

As in extension of the Christian ministries of Gloria Dei Lutheran Church, our objective is to provide an environment that fosters love, patience, security and care for each child entrusted to us regardless of race, creed, sex, or national origin.

PHILOSOPHY

We are concerned with developing the total child through social, intellectual, physical, emotional and spiritual growth. We believe that children learn by doing and therefore we strive to provide each child with a supportive environment in which they can develop his or her skills and abilities. We encourage, stimulate, challenge, love and praise each child. Our curriculum encourages warmth and love due all children with emphasis on their individual needs, interest, and abilities being of prime importance.

ACCEPTANCE INTO THE PROGRAM

A child is placed within the preschool according to his or her age and developmental ability. If a child has difficulty adjusting to the preschool a conference with the parents and teacher may result in finding an alternative placement for the child.

Gloria Dei Preschool and Kindergarten admits students of any race, color, national and ethnic origin to all the rights, privileges, programs and activities generally accorded or made available to students within the school. It does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national and ethnic origin in the administration of its educational policies, admissions policies, athletic policies or any other school-administered programs.

GENERAL INFORMATION

The Preschool follows the Edmonds School District calendar. This applies to holidays only. If the Edmonds schools are closed due to weather, we will be closed. If the district is running one to two hours late we will attempt to run on regular schedule. Parents are to use their own judgment based on the weather conditions in their own area.

A snack is provided in all school classes.

Children should dress for "hands-on" activities and appropriate for weather conditions

Field trips are taken on occasion and parents are encouraged to participate. Permission slips and legal car seats are required for all children to attend. Criminal background checks and adequate auto insurance are required for all drivers.

ILLNESS POLICY

Children who come to Preschool should be well enough to participate in all activities including outside play. Children who come to school unable to participate will be sent home at the discretion of the teacher. If your child is ill or not feeling well please keep him or her home, as we want to protect staff and other children from the possibility of being exposed to communicable illnesses. The school should be notified if a child will not be attending school

GUIDANCE POLICY

Young children are learning to get along in groups away from home. The role of the teacher is to help children learn acceptable ways to achieve the goals they seek. Teachers give children cues and instructions about which behaviors to maintain or avoid and which alternative behaviors may be more successful. A positive approach to guidance is used giving children choices, by using indirect guidance and positive redirection. The staff does not spank; the staff allows no type of corporal punishment, verbal or frightening, humiliating or otherwise harmful tactics.

The school's aim is to provide positive reinforcement for each individual so as to encourage a positive self-image and a desire to participate and learn. We respect each child as an individual who can develop inner controls necessary in the building self-respect and acceptance by the group.

CHILD ABUSE AND NEGLECT

While we hope never to be faced with these situations it is important that our policy be clearly stated. We are required by law to report to Child Protective Services any suspicious circumstances having to do with a child's physical, psychological, emotional health or well-being.

FIRE AND EMERGENCY EVACUATION PLAN

In case of a fire or other emergency requiring the building to be evacuated, the children will be escorted to the southeast corner of Gloria Dei Church property (on the embankment off Larch Way). If we are unable to return to the building, we will transport the children to Church of the Good Shepherd, 2609 Larch Way; approximately ½ mile east of Gloria Dei Church. Parents may pick up their children at this location. Parents will be notified by telephone as soon as possible.

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

2-Day Class:

This class is designed for children who are 2 ½ to 3 ½ years old with potty training started. The emphasis in this class is on developing self-help, communication, and social skills. Children will learn to direct their own activity and make choices regarding the activities they choose to do. Each child is able to work at his or her own ability level.

3-Day Class:

This class is an extension of the 2-day class. Children entering this class are 3 ½ to 4 ½ years old. The emphasis continues to be on the development of self help, communication and social skills. The same types of activities presented in the 2-day class are available. Scissors are introduced in this class and children are encouraged to learn to print their name.

4-Day Class:

Pre-Kindergarten:

This class offers more structure and is designed for older fours and five year olds that are not yet entering kindergarten. Children entering this class require a longer attention span with an ability to participate in group activities. Alphabet skills are emphasized through visual observation, sounds, writing and signing. Math skills are developed through number recognition and a beginning understanding of math functions. Science, social studies, literature, music, arts and crafts, and physical education activities are also part of the curriculum. Children will be encouraged to learn to print their name and know their address and telephone number. Topics for learning will be theme oriented and seasonal and will be literature based. A calendar will be provided each month to inform parents of daily topics and activities.

Kindergarten:

This class is a half-day four-day a week program designed to provide children with the continuity and consistency that best bridges the transition from preschool to first grade. Students will begin to read, write, and learn basic math skills, all of which are essential for the learning and development in other subjects such as art, music, science, social studies, health and physical education. The curriculum will provide challenging and successful learning experiences for all students at their own level with activities and thematic units designed to integrate learning in all areas. The classroom will accommodate up to twelve students with special learning centers and a computer lab.

All of the classes use developmentally appropriate practices. Activity centers are used throughout the programs. All classes offer art, music, dance, puppets, stories, and outdoor play. A computer lab is also available for exploration in the pre-k and kindergarten classrooms. Field trips may be planned for all classes.

Gloria Dei Preschool and Kindergarten is a Christian school. We incorporate prayer into our classroom at snack time and with many of the songs the children sing during circle time. Chapel may also be a weekly part of the class time depending on the Pastor's availability.

Fee Schedule for 2010-2011 Term

Age Requirements

2-DAY CLASS: Children must be 2 ½ years old by the first of September of the current year to be eligible for the 2-day class (M/W and T/Th).

3-DAY CLASS: Children must be at least 3 ½ years old by the first of September of the current year in order to be eligible for the 3-day class (M/W/F a.m. and p.m.).

4-DAY PRE-KINDERGARTEN CLASS: Children must be at least 4 ½ years old by the first of September of the current year in order to be eligible for the 4-day pre-kindergarten class (M-T-W-Th a.m. and p.m.).

KINDERGARTEN: Students must be 5 years of age by the first of September of the current year in order to be eligible for the kindergarten class (M-T-W-Th a.m. and p.m. if demand dictates.).

There is a 10% discount for families with two children in the preschool and 15% for three or more. Gloria Dei members receive a 10% discount on their monthly tuition.

Payment Policies

Payment for Preschool is due the 1st of each month in advance. You will not be billed. Payment not received by the 10th may result in a \$15.00 late fee. If tuition for a given month is not paid in full by the 25th of the month, termination of services may result and the position will be considered open for enrollment of another student. Any bank charges incurred for returned (NSF) checks would be due and payable. Fees are subject to change on need.

THERE ARE NO DISCOUNTS OR REFUNDS FOR ABSENCES OR ILLNESSES.

A two-week notice is required for a student withdrawal. If a student is withdrawn any time during a given month, tuition is due for the entire month if a two-week notice is not received.

Students who start school after the 15th of the month will pay one-half (1/2) of the tuition that month. This is in effect for all months except September, when full tuition is due regardless of start date.

The children will go on field trips periodically. Expenses for trips are kept low or free when possible. Any field trip charge is usually paid directly to the teacher.

A \$25 fee will be charged for children left at school 10 minutes after dismissal without prior arrangements.

EMERGENCY KITS

In the event of an earthquake or some other natural disaster or weather condition, we ask that you provide a comfort kit for your child. This is designed to provide short-term aid for your child in the way of warmth, nourishment and security if for some reason our building is unable to provide this. We ask that these kits be brought to school as soon as possible as one can never predict a natural disaster. *Kits will be available for purchase at parent orientation night at a very reasonable price. You may wish to purchase a prepackaged kit and add your own personal touches.*

PROCEDURE FOR EARTHQUAKES:

When practicing fire drills, we include earthquake preparedness. During the initial quake the children are instructed to drop to the floor/ground and cover their head with their hands/arms. If possible they are to get under a table away from the windows. Immediately following the quake we will check for injuries and treat appropriately. The building will be checked and the water/power/gas turned off. If we are able to remain in the building, the children will be relocated to the hallway and made as comfortable as possible to wait pick-up. If the building needs to be evacuated, we will wait outside in the grass area just beyond the parking lot unless the weather is unsatisfactory. If the children need to be moved to another location a note will be posted on the playground fence. One possible location would be the Church of the Good Shepherd just east of Gloria Dei on Larch Way. Phones may be out of service or circuits may be jammed. In either event communication may be difficult if not impossible. We will do all we can to help each child feel safe and secure until parents arrive. SUGGESTED ITEMS TO INCLUDE IN KIT:

Picture of child – labeled	Granola Bar
Juice Box	Package of Tissues
Picture of the family, pet, etc.	A note of encouragement
Socks and gloves	Any other items you feel necessary
Survival Blanket (also called space blanket found in sporting goods)	

Place all items in a Ziploc storage bag marked with your child's name along with a picture of your child if possible for easy identification. The kits will be stored in an outside storage shed for easy access. We can never be too prepared and we want to provide the very best for your child. Thank you for your help.

SAFETY PRACTICES

If anyone calls asking about a child or whether or not a child is here, our standard answer is, "for the safety of the children, we cannot give that information over the phone."

Because children are much more likely to go off with a stranger who calls them by name, we no longer identify children on field trips with nametags. Their tags give the name, address and phone number of the school only.

The door at the west end of the school hall is an exit door only. Parents and students may exit through that door but must enter through the main church doors. Only staff, students and parents are allowed in the school during school hours. Anyone having a need to be in the school area must check in at the church office and wear a visitor tag. Anyone without a visitor will be stopped and questioned.

No child will be released to anyone other than the custodial parent or those people listed on their registration forms without prior authorization. A note from a parent or verbal authorization must be given over the phone or the child will not be released.
